Top things to know about this plan

Q. Is this plan new?

A. Yes, this is a new ACA Marketplace plan exclusively through UnitedHealthcare in partnership with Sanitas Medical Centers. It is only offered to San Antonio, Texas residents. The plan is available for coverage starting January 1, 2026. You can enroll in the plan during the open enrollment period, which begins November 1, 2025.

Q. Who is Sanitas?

A. Sanitas Medical Centers offer primary health care services in locations all over the world. UnitedHealthcare is partnering with Sanitas Medical Centers in the San Antonio area to help you and your family focus on your best health. This is called a health system partnership plan, which is when a health insurance plan (UnitedHealthcare) works with a specific care network system (Sanitas Medical Centers).

Q. What is a value-based care (VBC) plan?

A. Value-based care plans focus on delivering quality, low-cost care that supports your health and well-being. By managing all your care through a Sanitas primary care provider, you'll build a relationship with a provider who knows your health history and can refer you to trusted specialists when needed. And, because your care team all work together within the Sanitas network, you'll enjoy more predictable costs while getting care that's designed around your life.

Q. Will I get a Primary Care Provider (PCP) assigned?

A. When you join this plan, you'll be assigned a Sanitas PCP. If you need a specialist, start with your Sanitas PCP to help coordinate care. Please note that there are a few affiliate providers currently in network but they might not remain in network every year.

Q. Do I need a referral to see a specialist?

A. Yes, with a UnitedHealthcare Sanitas plan, you'll need to manage all your care through a primary care provider. That means if you need care from a specialist, like an allergist or cardiologist, your PCP will first need to submit a referral for you to make sure the services are in network and covered by your plan. Known as a "gated" plan, this type of coverage may help save you money and ensure you're getting the right kind of care.

Q. Can I only see Sanitas providers?

A. With these plans, seeing your Sanitas Medical Center primary care provider (PCP) is your first step to getting care. Your PCP will help you stay on top of your health and refer you to network specialists as needed. If you choose to see a non-Sanitas care provider or specialist, that visit will cost more because it's not covered by your plan. You can find or verify a Sanitas provider by visiting "Member sign-in" at uhc.com/sanitas or calling the number on the back of your health plan ID card.

Q. Can I only visit Sanitas clinic locations?

A. Unless it is a medical emergency, your first step in getting care should be your local Sanitas Medical Center. This will help you get the lowest cost of care. If you choose to visit a non-Sanitas clinic, that visit will cost more because it's not covered by your plan.
