

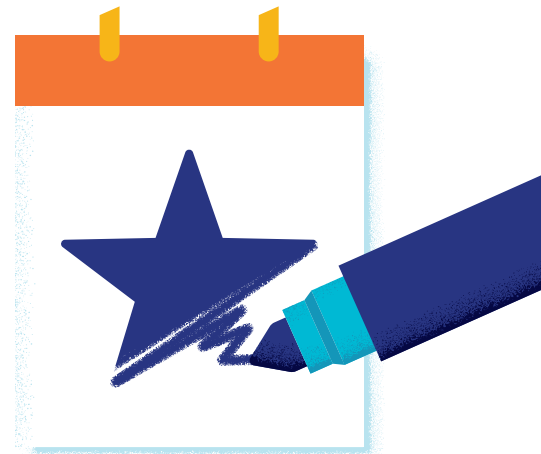

Access plan information with your online account

Enjoy the same features as the app provides by going online at myAARPMedicare.com. You'll have access to:

- An online way to pay monthly premiums.
- A way to see where you are on meeting your Medicare Part B deductible by viewing the spend and cost summary on the main page of your online account.
- Sign up for electronic delivery to receive your documents faster, such as your Medicare Supplement EOBs. You will also receive Medicare EOBs directly from Medicare. If Medicare approves your medical service or supply, your claim will then be processed based on the specific benefits provided under your plan.
