Bi-annual allowance period

Most members don't need new glasses every year, in fact, 75% of members use their allowance benefit every two years. To align, the eyewear allowance period will extend to two years for Non-SNP, C-SNP and Partial D-SNP members. Most I-SNP and Full D-SNP members will continue to receive an annual eyewear allowance.



Predictable copays

Non-SNP members who want to upgrade their lenses will pay copays in 2025 offering more cost protection than last year's discount.
