Special Supplemental Benefits for the Chronically Ill (SSBCI) Member Communications

Overview

- Special Supplemental Benefits for the Chronically III (SSBCI) is a program that allows Medicare Advantage plans to offer additional benefits to members with one or more complex conditions. With VBID ending, UnitedHealthcare will continue offering healthy food and utilities benefits through SSBCI. D-SNP members may now need to take steps to qualify for SSBCI. Learn more about SSBCI in our Quick Reference Guide.
- Prospects and existing members should be notified about SSBCI updates to help them understand the changes and stay informed about their eligibility.

Key Objectives


• Create awareness of new eligibility requirement to use OTC credits toward healthy food and utilities, and help guide members through a seamless verification process.

Timing

- All prospects and existing members have access to education focusing on the CMS changes. This includes articles, videos, FAQs, and content on the UHC Agent Toolkit (see page 2).
- Existing members received their Annual Notice of Change (ANOC) in September, which outlined the VBID changes and plan impact (see page 2).
- Many existing members will automatically qualify for SSBCI benefits, and they will be notified by direct mail that they are eligible (see page 3). Existing members that aren't already verified can share information about their qualifying complex conditions on the member site.
- Starting 10/1, members will be directed to the Plan for Next Year (PFNY) page on the member portal from communications. PFNY will feature the SSBCI Eligibility status indicator.
- Starting in late November, members will receive the OTC+ Benefit Introduction via mail and/or email. This message shares a benefit overview, notes SSBCI eligibility if applicable, and directs members to the UCard Hub for details.
- Members will receive their new UCard in the mail, which will include information on how they can use their monthly credits and directs to the UCard Hub.
- Members who have shared information about their qualifying condition but haven't been verified for SSBCI will be able to spend their credits on healthy foods and utilities while we verify their condition with their provider. They will receive a reminder letter or email to encourage them to check with their provider about confirming their condition (see page 4).
- If verification fails, members receive a final letter to notify them (see page 4). If they are verified later in the plan year, they will have immediate access to use credits for healthy food and utilities.



Important note: Medicare has decided to end the VBID program on Dec. 31, 2025. This is an industry-wide change that impacts all Medicare Advantage insurance carriers.
