#### Any dual-eligible consumer can enroll in a UHC D-SNP plan during AEP and MA-OEP

  - f. Was affected by a weather-related emergency or major disaster (as declared by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)).
  - Enrolled in a plan by Medicare (or the state) and wants to choose a different plan within 3 months. g.
  - h. Delayed enrollment into Medicare Part B and now has Part B (ICEP-Delayed Part B).
  - i. Recently enrolled in a Medicare Advantage plan for the first time and wants to make a change during the first 3 months of enrollment.
