



Effective Feb. 12, 2026, UnitedHealthcare will transition to eligibility underwriting in Virginia for AARP® Medicare Supplement Insurance Plans insured by UnitedHealthcare® Insurance Company (UHIC). This includes all new enrollments and current insured members changing plans outside of the Annual Birthday Enrollment, Guaranteed Issue, or Medicare Supplement Open Enrollment Periods.

Applications will be required for all current insured members moving from one AARP Medicare Supplement Plan to another AARP Medicare Supplement Plan (with the exception of changing to UHIC plans A, K and L)¹, even when changing plans during the Annual Birthday Enrollment Period.

New applications for Virginia will be required starting Feb. 12, 2026.

New applications will be included in the Virginia Enrollment Kits starting Feb. 12, 2026, on the Sales Materials Portal, accessible via [Jarvis](#).

Please do not download or order large amounts of Enrollment Kits now. Any kits ordered prior to Feb. 12, 2026, will be outdated and the applications will not be the correct version.

Please ensure your clients promptly sign applications submitted through JarvisEnroll as applications will be changing on Feb. 12, 2026.²
