



Update for AARP Medicare Supplement Plans in Maine

Beginning **April 9, 2026**, when an individual between the ages of 50-64 in Maine applies for an AARP® Medicare Supplement Insurance Plan insured by UnitedHealthcare® Insurance Company outside their Medicare Supplement Open Enrollment (OE) or Guaranteed Issue (GI) periods, they will be able to continue with the enrollment process by answering health questions and going through underwriting. A new question on the Maine application, 6A, will be added to the health questions section.

This new question will apply to applicants ages 50-64 and 65+.

Question 6A:

- Were you first enrolled in Medicare prior to age 65 due to a disability, End-Stage Renal (Kidney) Disease (ESRD) or Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS)?

New applications for Maine will be required starting April 9, 2026.

New applications will be included in the Maine Enrollment Kits starting April 9, 2026, on the Sales Materials Portal, accessible via [Jarvis](#).

Please do not download or order large amounts of Enrollment Kits now. Any kits ordered prior to April 9, 2026, will be outdated and the applications will not be the correct version.
