Summary of 2027 Enrollment Requirements

New 2027 CMS Alignment Requirements Apply in Idaho

- In 2027, there are new exclusively aligned enrollment CMS requirements for Full Dual eligibles (FBDE, QMB+) where UHC offers managed Medicaid:
 - One Full Dual Plan Option per Service Area. Full dual members will have only one UHC plan available per service area. If a consumer has LTSS, they are eligible to join UHC Dual Complete ID-YL; if a consumer is full dual, but does not have LTSS, then they are eligible to join UHC Dual Complete ID-Y1.
 - New Full Dual Enrollees Will Be Aligned with UHC for Both Medicare and Medicaid. Full Dual members who newly enroll in a UHC D-SNP must be enrolled with UHC for both their Medicare and Medicaid coverage. If a member joins a UHC D-SNP and is enrolled in a different Medicaid plan, their Medicaid coverage will automatically transition to UHC's Medicaid plan after D-SNP enrollment. **Note:** Consumers must already be enrolled in Medicaid before enrolling in a Full Dual D-SNP.

Any Dual-Eligible Consumer Can Enroll During AEP And MA-OEP, With Limitations During SEP

Summary of Medicaid Requirements

To enroll in UHC Dual Complete ID-YL or UHC Dual Complete ID-Y1, consumers must be enrolled in a Medicaid plan.

Medicaid Options: Dual-eligibles have two programs available to them in Idaho: the Medicare Medicaid Coordinated Plan (MMCP) and the Idaho Medicaid Plus Program (IMPlus).

- Medicare Medicaid Coordinated Plan (MMCP). The MMCP is a voluntary program that integrates both Medicare and Medicaid coverage into one single plan.
- Idaho Medicaid Plus (IMPlus). Mandatory managed care program that covers all Medicaid enhanced plan benefits and will give the member the option to choose their Medicare health plan if they live in select counties and aren't enrolled in the MMCP.

Medicaid Enrollment Process: Agents may not assist clients in signing up for a Medicaid Managed Care plan. Simply direct the client to the Medicaid URL and phone numbers below.
